INHOUSE

- > The Documentation Centre provides researchers, professors, students and the general public with documentation in sport law, humanities, and economics.
- > Library is open Monday to Friday during CIES opening hours 8.30-12.00 and 13.30-17.30
- > Studying in the reading room between 12.00 and 14.00 pm (Monday-Friday) is occasionally possible on appointment.
- > Loans on site are free of charge.
- > Loans are for a period of up to 1 month. A reduced loan time of 2 weeks may be applied for the sake of the FIFA Master course.
- > Some restrictions on loans are applied to the sport law collection (red stickers).
- > CIES is part of a network of Swiss libraries (https://explore.rero.ch/fr_CH/rero). Books from other libraries may be borrowed (paying service).

How do I get a login and a password to use the loan service in CIES?

-> You need to be registered by your CIES librarian on the basis of your student ID card delivered by the University of Neuchâtel or any ID card having the Swiss Bibliopass logo on it.

May I return books belonging to the IOC library to the CIES documentation centre ?

Yes, but only if you are enrolled in the FIFA Master programme !
